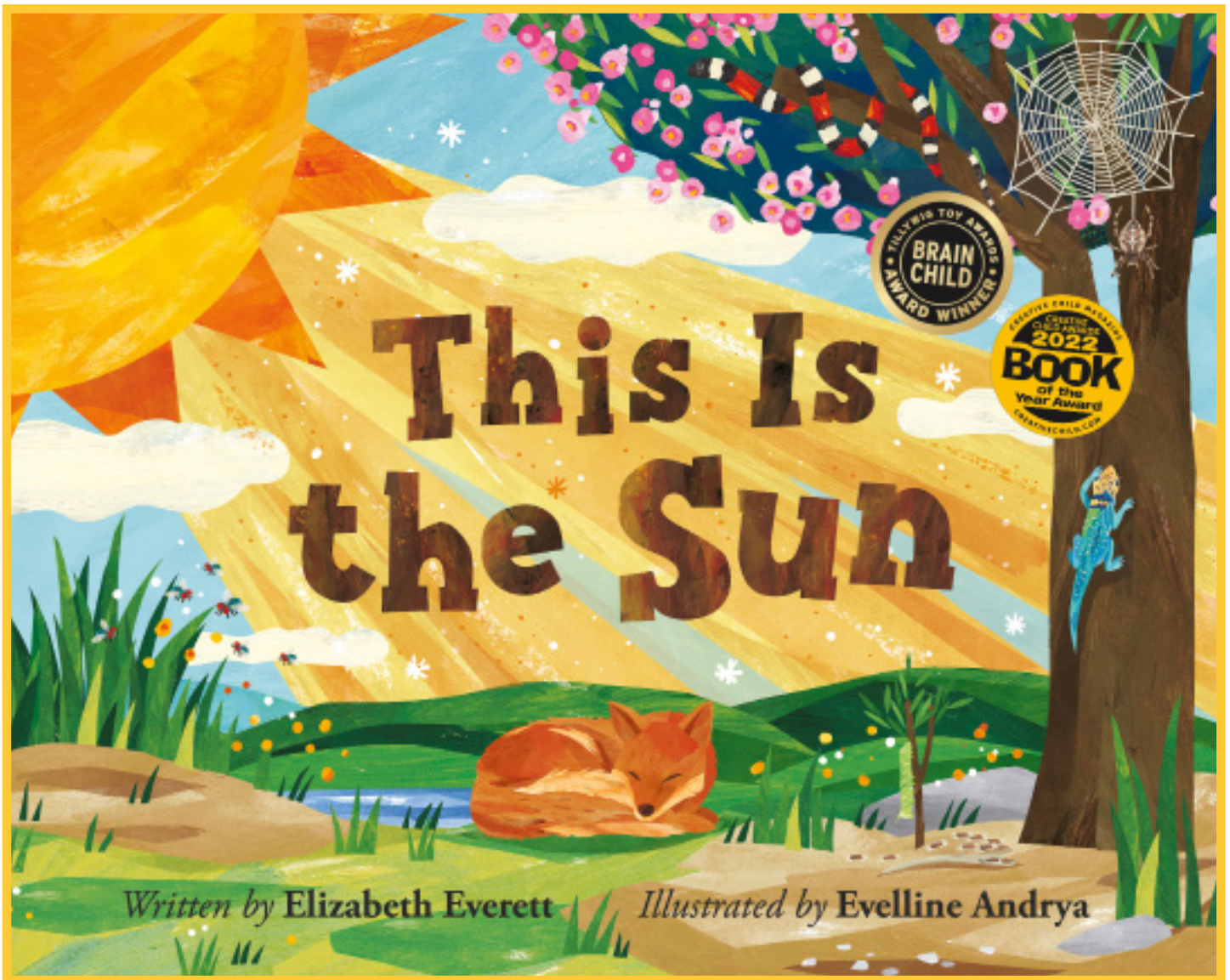

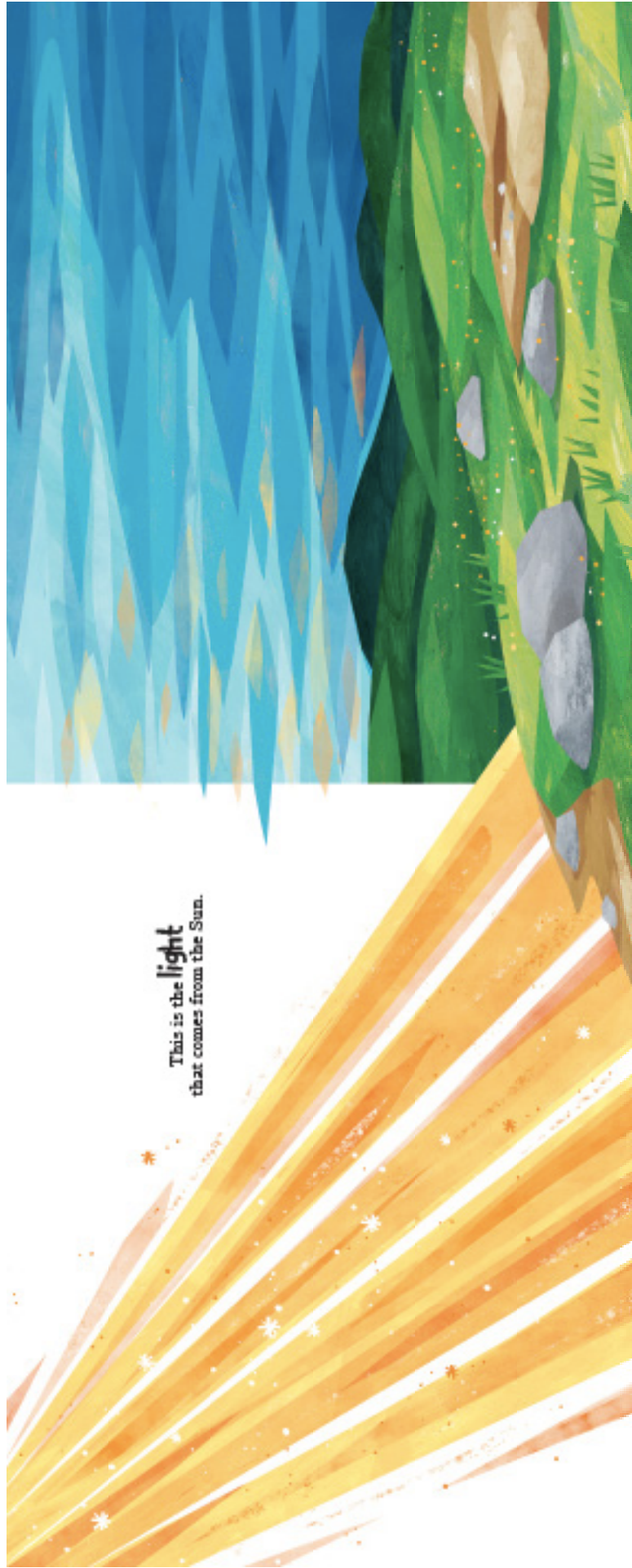

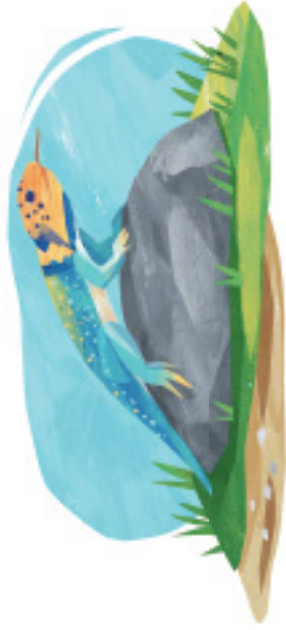
This is the **flower** that starts to bloom as it grows on the tree

that uses the light from the Sun to make its own food.

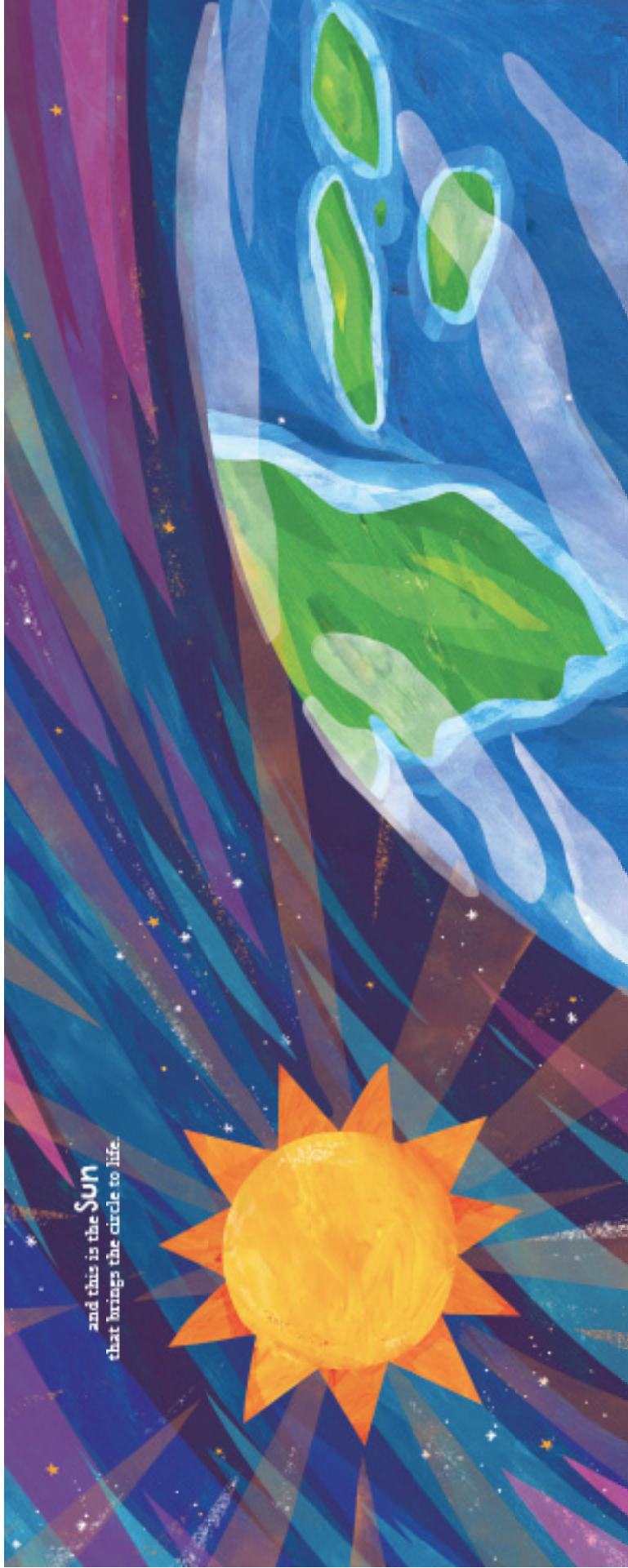


This is the **seed** that comes from the tree and lands in the scat
