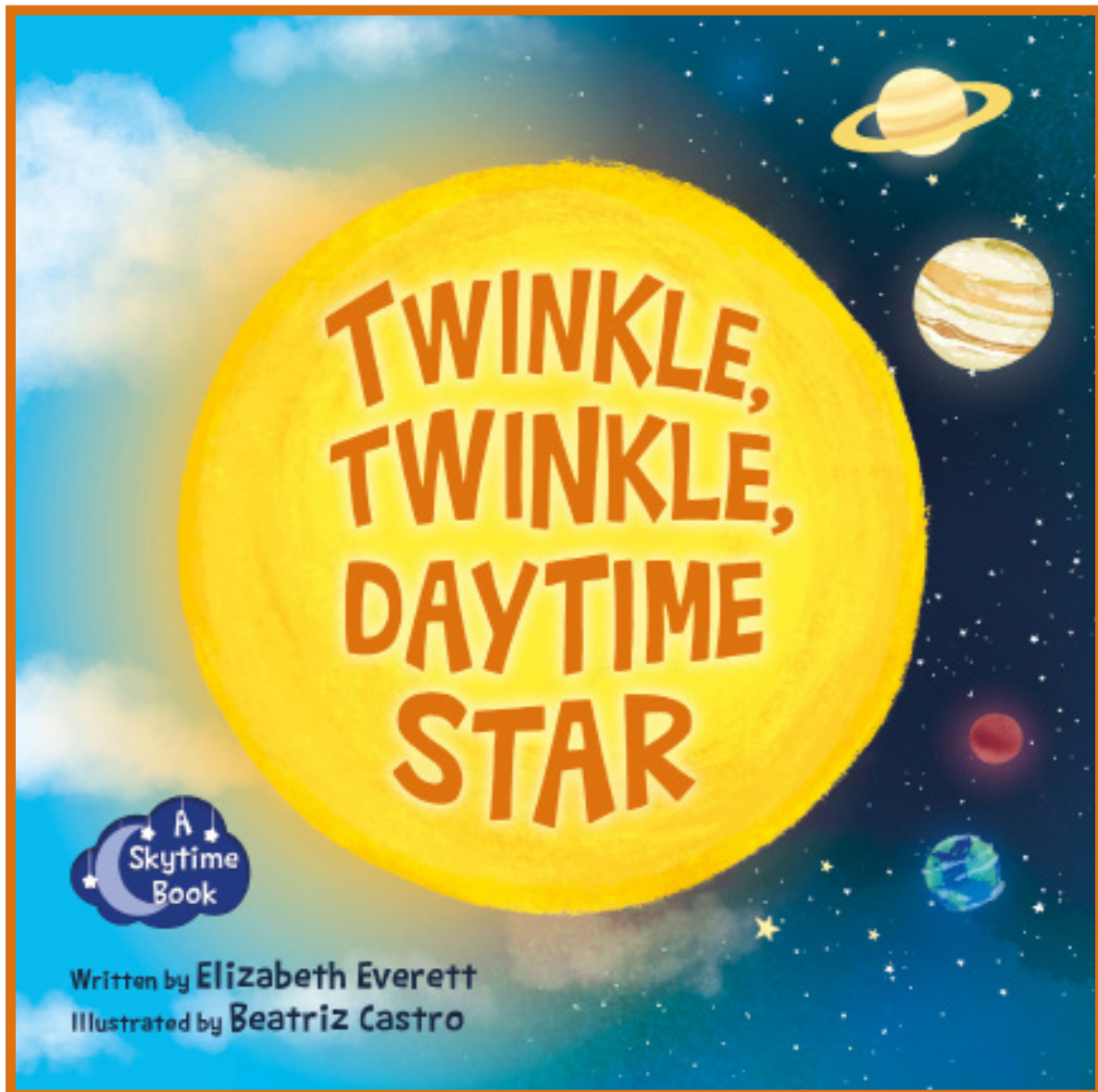

you help us to make vitamins.

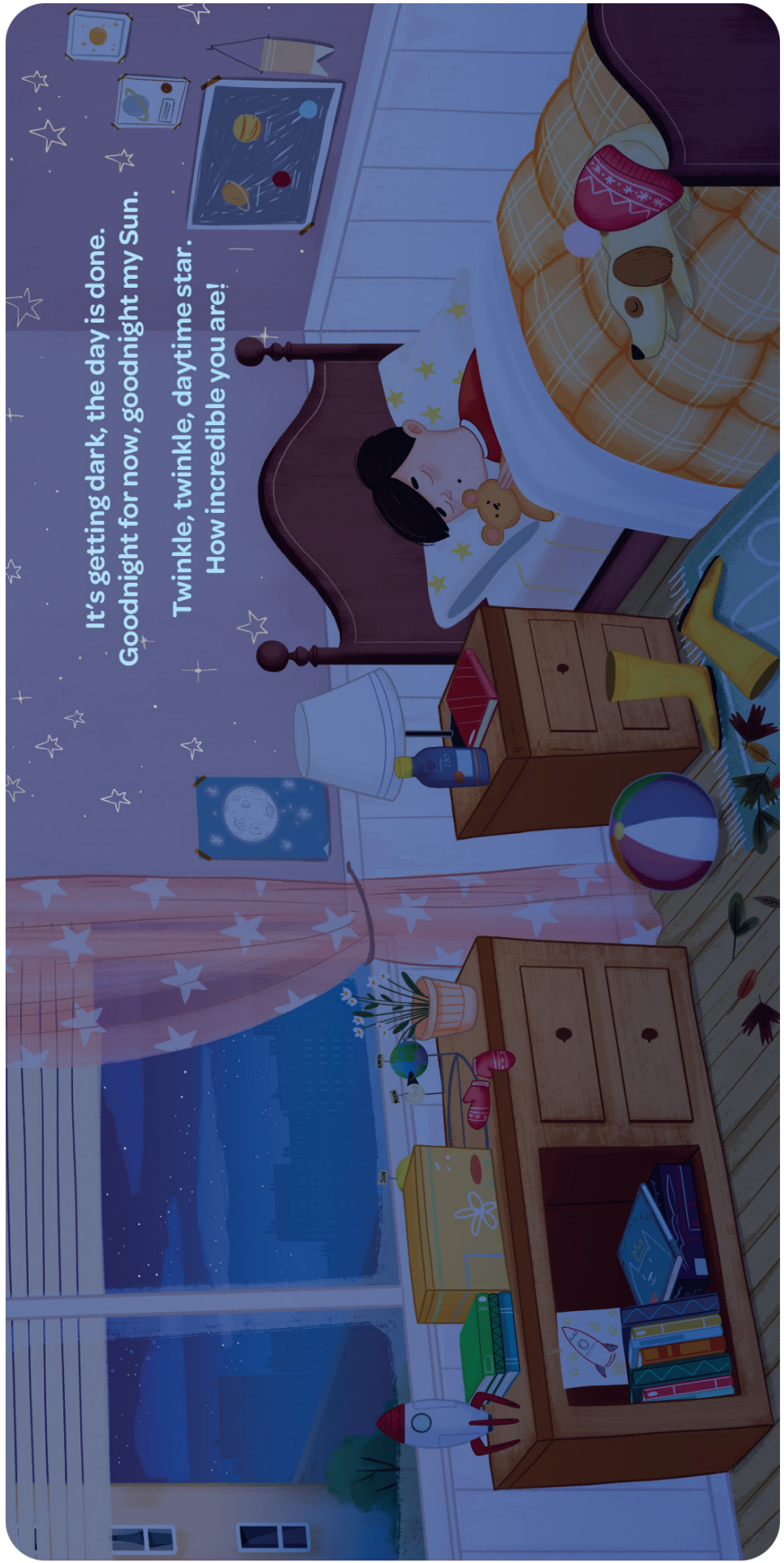
But sometimes you can be too strong!

puddles, worms, and growing flowers.

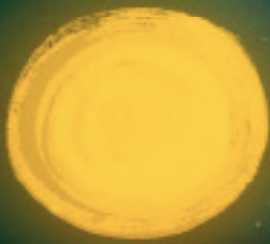
Summer's here; long days bring heat.
